Bank to Payback Military Families

Wells Fargo & Department of wells Fargo amp; Co. will pay \$175 to any eligible veteran who had a Department of

Veterans Affairs Loan refinanced between Jan. 20, 2004, and Oct. 7, 2010, the bank said Tuesday. The move comes as part of a court settlement in a Georgia lawsuit that alleged the bank overcharged active-duty military personnel when they executed the refinances. Federal law protects active-duty military members from foreclosure and high interest rates. Wells Fargo will alert eligible households with letters. The bank could pay out up to a total of \$10 million. This marks the second major concession by big banks to military families this year. Last month, JPMorgan Chase & Co. refunded \$2 million to 4,000 service members who'd been forced to pay high interest rates.

TRICARE Co-Pays Likely to Increase

Under the proposed 2012 DoD budget, TRICARE prescriptions filled on base will remain free, but, co-pays for medications purchased at retail pharmacies will increase; the current \$3 co-pay for generics at retail outlets will increase to \$5 and the \$9 co-pays for brand name drugs will climb to \$12. "Tier 3" (non-formulary brand) drugs, which currently cost beneficiaries a \$22 co-pay will be raised to \$25 for both mail order and retail.

Bills Offers Support for Military Spouses

Congress is currently considering several bills which would have a positive impact on the lives military spouses and their families. Three of the most recent bills are S. 260 and H.R 178, which would eliminate the so-called "Widow's Tax" -- otherwise known as the SBP Offset - and H.R. 687. H.R. 687, also referred to as the "Military Spouse Employment Act," was introduced by John Carter (R-TX). If passed this bill would offer employers a tax credit for hiring spouses of members of the Armed Forces on extended active duty for more than 90 days.

Stop Loss Pay Deadline

The deadline for eligible members or legally designated beneficiaries to apply for Retroactive Stop Loss Special Pay is coming on March 4. Airmen who were involuntarily held on active duty between Sept. 11, 2001, and September 30, 2009, may be eligible for the special pay compensation of \$500 for each month they were affected. For more information or to file a claim, download a stop loss claim application at the Air Force Personnel Center's Retroactive Stop Loss Special Pay webpage.

To sign up, eligible travelers must present a DOD-issued ID card (for ages 10 and up) and appropriate travel authorization or, for active duty personnel, current leave paperwork. Eligible travelers can sign up for Space-A in person at any passenger terminal, or by fax, email, Internet or regular mail.
